These are just some of the areas where we help apprentices overcome their learning difficulties.

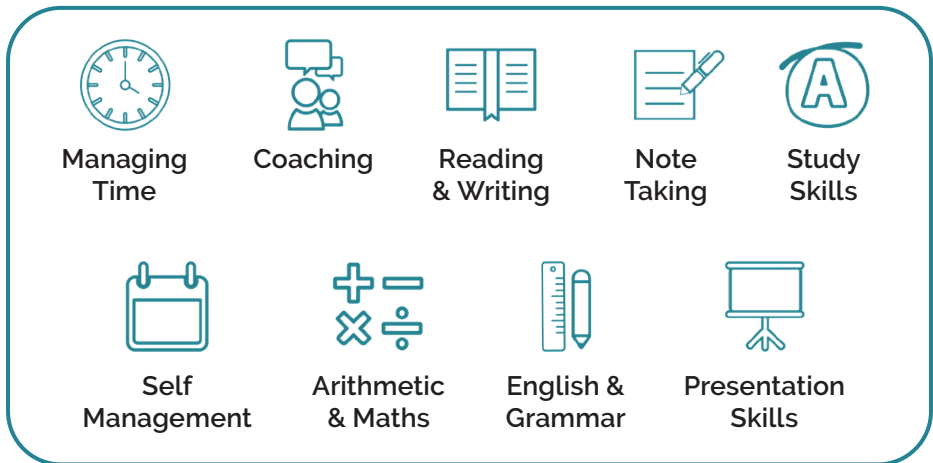
