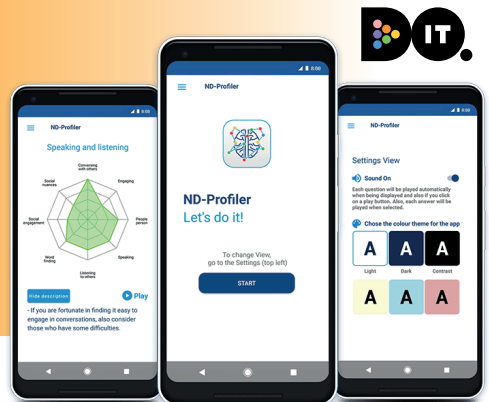
In short – to help you to succeed.
